Important Information

Camp begins each day at 9 a.m. and ends promptly at 4:30 p.m.

Each camper must bring with him to camp everyday:

- Full water bottle and sunscreen (water and Gatorade on site for refills)
- Soccer ball (Size 4 for 7-10 year olds, Size 5 for 11 year olds and up)
Balls will be available to purchase all week long for \$30
- Soccer cleats (while on the fields) and shinguards (must be worn during all soccer activities)
- Sneakers or sandals (while at the cafeteria) and rain jacket (in case of inclement weather)
- For swimming pool (Tues, Thur, Fri); sandals, towel, sunscreen, and swimsuit (with internal liner)
- Snacks. We provide lunch each day but we do not provide any kind of snacks for the campers on the fields.

Camp Check-In on Monday Morning

Bring this letter with you to check-in. Check-in begins at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, the first day of camp, at the east end of Mitchell Fields. Camp orientation on Monday will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. We will provide curbside service for check-in. You do not have to leave your car. We'll collect your remaining camp balance, health forms, and issue your son his camp t-shirt as he gets out of the car to start camp. If you need to speak to coaches or trainers in greater detail before the camp begins, you can park across the street at the Art and Architecture metered parking lot and walk over to the fields.

Facilities/Pool

Camp is conducted on Mitchell Fields, located on Fuller Rd. between the U-M Hospital and Veteran's Hospital (map included). Lunch will be eaten at U-M's Bursley Residence Hall Cafeteria (3/4 of a mile away). Campers will be shuttled to lunch by bus. After lunch, campers will be bused to Fuller Pool for swimming, water slide, and rest (3 out of 5 days: Tues, Thur, and Fri., weather permitting). In addition to coaching staff supervision, certified lifeguards are on duty at all times at Fuller Pool. After Fuller Pool, campers will walk back to Mitchell Field with their coach and team. For the 2 out of 5 days we do not go to the pool, we will take the buses back to the fields to begin our small-sided games after a rest period in the cafeteria after lunch.

Medical Care & Insurance

Our athletic trainers will be on site at all times to administer attention to minor ailments. U-M Hospital will be utilized for more serious injuries. Camper's health insurance is the primary coverage. The camp provides secondary accident/medical coverage.

Daily Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Camp begins at 9 a.m. and concludes at 4:30 p.m. Coaching staff arrives and departs 30 minutes before and after these times respectively. For an additional fee, we will provide care 90 minutes before and/or after camp. Drop-off your camper at the East end of the Mitchell Field parking lot. Pick-up your camper directly from the field where he'll be playing his large-sided game at the end of the day, (our staff will direct you). Parking in the Mitchell Field lot is by permit only. Michigan Men's Soccer LLC, is not responsible for parking infractions.

Camp Policies

Dismissal Policy

Both the camp director and assistant directors reserve the right to dismiss any camper whose actions are deemed detrimental to the health and safety of other campers or himself, with no refund.

Foul Weather Policy

In case of tornado, electrical storm, or an extremely hard and sustained rain, campers will be bused to U-M's Bursley Residence Hall where videos will be shown. We will watch videos until we can safely resume outdoor soccer activities. If foul weather persists more than 2 hours without promise of clearing up, you are welcome to pick up your camper from the Bursley Dorm (1931 Duffield St., Ann Arbor, MI 48109). If morning weather is questionable, call our office phone for camp status (734-647-1201). No refunds for canceled sessions due to foul weather. If foul weather hits late in the day, we will release the campers from brick building located on Mitchell Fields.

Refund Policy

If a camper withdraws from camp at least one week prior to the start date, all funds paid to date will be returned minus a \$75 administrative fee. No refunds will be returned for any reason once a camp begins.

While not all campers will receive a post-camp award, sportsmanship is heavily emphasized in this camp. Camp award ceremony will begin at 4:10 p.m. on Friday (last day of camp) on the fields. Parents are invited to attend the award ceremony. Autographs will be signed afterwards.

Camp Store

Soccer balls will be available to purchase everyday during the camp for \$30. On the last day of camp, Friday, a camp store will be set up on Mitchell Field that will sell Michigan Soccer t-shirts, balls, bumper stickers, replica jerseys, etc.
