Check-In, Meals

- Check-in will be held between 8-9 a.m. on the fields (2250 South State St., Ann Arbor, 48104) before the start of the camp on either June 18 or July 15.
- At check-in you will receive your t-shirt and itinerary for the camp. You will also be expected to complete any release forms that you did not send prior to the camp or bring with you.
- **Room and board is not provided by the camp.** You are responsible for your own lodging and meals. We have a list of hotels that are very close to the fields on our website. There are many restaurants around the hotels. At check-in, we will provide you with a list of restaurants near the fields and hotels.
- Michigan Men's Soccer, LLC, assumes no responsibility, nor will provide any supervision outside of camp hours or in the hotel. It will be the parent's responsibility, for those campers under the age of 18, to provide arrangements for supervision.

Things to Bring With You

- Your own soccer ball with name written on it. We do not provide balls as part of registration. Michigan Soccer balls are available to purchase at check-in for \$30.
- All necessary soccer gear including sandals, rain gear, shinguards, etc.
- You do not need to have access to your own transportation if you stay at the Sheraton Inn as this hotel provides a shuttle service for all soccer sessions. Otherwise, you need to provide your own transportation to and from the soccer fields.

- The camp director reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose actions are deemed detrimental to the health and/or safety of camp staff, other campers, or himself, with no refund.
- There will be no illegal drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes tolerated at the camp. Possession will result in immediate dismissal from the camp, with no refund.

Refund Policy

- If a camper withdraws from camp at least 24 hours prior to the start date, all funds paid to date will be returned minus a \$50 administrative fee. No refunds will be returned for any reason 24 hours prior to the start of camp.

Airport Transportation, Hotel Information

- For campers that will be flying into Detroit Metro Airport (DTW), there are several choices for shuttles services that can provide round trip transportation ranging from \$30-\$60. Go to our website (umsoccer.com/campinfoElite.html) for more information.

- Campers should plan return trip to airport after 4:00 p.m. on final day of camp.

Camp Check-Out

- Closing ceremonies will be from 3:30-4 p.m. on the last day of camp. Make arrangements with your hotel for “late check out” since the last session of the camp will begin at 2:30 p.m.

Miscellaneous Information

- Campers are required to attend each activity. Roll will be taken before every session.
- A guided tour of the U-M Athletic Campus will depart from the lobby of Yost Ice Arena at the following times. You do not need to call in advance to reserve your spot.
